Rosh Hashanah 5778 is just around the corner and the Sisterhood of Benai Asher, the Sephardic Congregation of Long Beach, would like to help you celebrate the holiday by sending a beautiful floral arrangement to your friends and neighbors.

We will provide a list of all the members of our synagogue. You choose the members to whom you would like the floral arrangement sent. We will send the flowers to each of the people on your list and include your name in an attached greeting.

We are combining our Rosh Hashana fundraiser with our Sisterhood membership renewal this year. Sisterhood membership is \$36/year or \$180 for a lifetime membership. If you join or renew your membership or are already a lifetime member, then you will be eligible for last year's prices of **\$36.00 for the first 3 people on your list and each additional person/family will be an additional \$5.00. If you wish to send to the entire list, the cost is \$180.00.**

If you choose not to renew or join the Sisterhood, the **first three people on your list will be \$41.00 and each additional person/family will be \$6.00. If you wish to send to the entire list, the cost will be \$198.00.**

Please note, there is an option on the form to reciprocate. If you check this box, if someone lists you whom you have not listed, we will automatically add their name and bill you directly. Please note, that if you are not a participant and just a recipient then you will be receiving a beautiful holiday card listing the people who have chosen to send you a floral arrangement.
